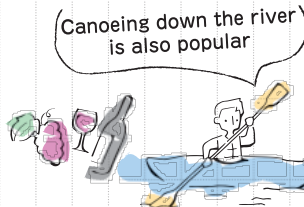

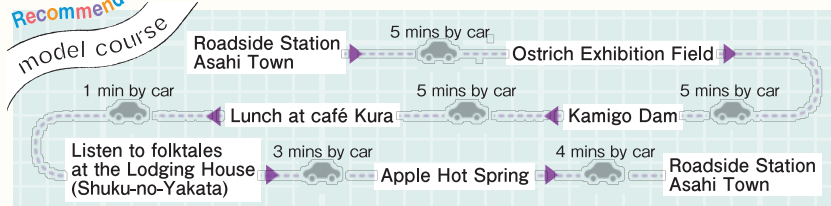
4 Experience folktales in an elegant old folk house

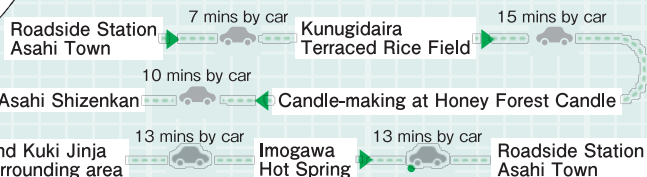

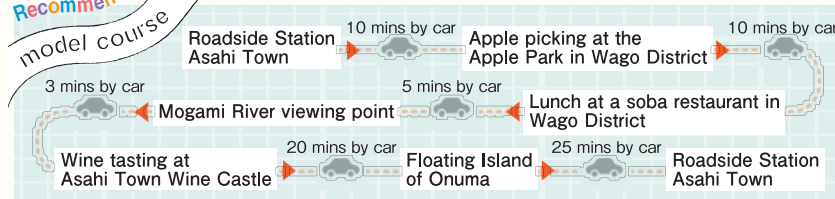
4 A walkable mysterious swamp that is surrounded by greenery

ASAHI TOWN ECO MUSEUM GUIDE

What is Eco Museum?

A unique museum concept that originated in France in which ruins, cultural assets and nature are preserved and observed on-site rather than being collected and displayed in a building like conventional museums. Asahi Town has compiled the basic concepts for eco museums for the first time in Japan and is working to create a tourist town through public and private cooperation.



POINT 1

NPO Corporation Asahi Town Eco Museum Association researches the history and culture of the town and publishes a booklet.

Booklets are sold that summarize interviews with townspeople and related organizations regarding nature and culture including "A Water and Life Exploration Team," "Onuma - The Scenic Floating Island" and "Otani Fujin Festival" in the Soyukan Eco Museum Room.



POINT 2

The Asahi Town Eco Museum Guide Association guides visitors to seasonal spots according to season and preference.



At the Asahi Town Eco Museum Guide Association, we explain the history, culture, nature and industry, etc., of Asahi Town in detail as townspeople serve as curators. Please feel free to pay us a visit.

EVENT CALENDAR

May 2 and 3

Horyu Shrine Rites and Festival

On May 2, a mikoshi (portable shrine) is carried from its shrine. On May 3, a children's mikoshi and lion dancing teams parade through the community.



Air Festival

May 5

Ukishima (floating island) Inari Shrine Annual Festival

The Annual Festival held on the "Floating Island of Onuma." Watch a procession of floating island court music, shrine priests and shrine parishioners as they make their way to the shrine.

June 5 and closest Saturday and Sunday

Air Festival

The main shrine of Kuki Jinja is opened only on these days. There are shrine maiden dances performed by local elementary school students and souvenirs that can only be bought on that day are sold.



Summer opening of the Asahi Mountain Range

Third Sunday in June

Summer opening of the Asahi Mountain Range

A ceremony offering a prayer for the safety climbers is performed at Asahidake Shrine on Mt. Torihara of the Asahi Mountain Range, which is one of Japan's famous 100 mountains.

First Saturday in June

Himesayuri (Rosy lily) Festival

Local cuisine and agricultural products including pickles made by local mothers are sold at Himesayuri Park in Ipponmatsu Park.



Asahi River Steam Festival

Third Sunday in July

Onuma Floating Island Festival

A festival featuring ukishima drums and court music in which everyone in the community participates. A new island is cut out from the lake bank.

First Sunday in August

Asahi River Steam Festival

Events including catching stream fish such as rainbow trout, mountain trout and landlocked salmon by hand and treasure hunts are held.

August 15

Kasuga Shrine Annual Rites and Festival (leap year of the old calendar)

A Daimyo procession is held in the leap year of the old lunar calendar. Traditional performing art showcasing the Yatsunuma Lion Dance and Yakkoburi (servant dance) are presented.



Asahi Town Wine festival

August 31

Otani Fujin Festival

This festival protects against wind storms and disasters and prays for a good harvest. A fireworks display, procession of lion dancers and Dengaku lanterns, and performances by each district are the highlights.

Autumnal Equinox Day

Asahi Town Wine festival

Drink all you want red, white, and rose wine while enjoying a BBQ. The grape stomping competition is also a big hit. By advance ticket purchase only.



Industry Festival

The final Saturday and Sunday of November

Apple Festival, Industry Festival

A lively event with the opening of local furniture and restaurant shops in addition to agricultural products such as bag-less Fuji apples. Events such as rice cake scattering and apple fishing are also held.

Late December

Opening of Asahi Shizenkan Ski Resort

Start of the ski season. Check for discount service days for lift fares.

Late January or early February

Ski Resort Festival

There are many events held at Asahi Shizenkan Snow Park that you can only experience in snowy regions.
